

[A MESSAGE FROM MARK]

For as in one body we have many members, and not all the members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another. (Romans 12:4-5)

Paul writes in Romans that as a church we are one body, but with many parts. Each week through the words of the Creed (statement of belief) and Collect, we recognize that we are part of the worldwide Christian Church. Sometimes that can be difficult to comprehend as we sit in the Discovery School each Sunday. However this month we get to recognize the place St Gabriel's plays as part of the wider Church in the Diocese and Cluster.

On July 10th, we recognize our place as part of the Diocese of Rochester and serve them and our community of Kings Hill, by hosting the 'Make your Mark' Children's and young peoples festival (see opposite). This will be a great day for both the Diocese and Kings Hill, as the wider community and church come together. Full of activities for all ages, it will be a fusion of activities, worship and community witness. As a Church we will support the event by providing refreshments, but also taking part in the activities and inviting our friends.

A week later (17th July, 6pm) we have our summer Cluster service. The service will be a celebration of the Cluster and the links that have been built up by it through St Mary's, West Malling with the Lutheran Church in Estonia. As part of the Diocesan links with other countries, the relationship between two worshipping communities has been built up over many years. Church members have traveled between the countries to learn about culture and church in each community. A mutual sharing that develops understanding of life and culture.

So come along to the events and discover what it is for us as members of St Gabriel's to be truly members of the wider Christian community in the diocese and around the world.


