

A great, mess free craft activity to stay entertained while travelling.

You Will Need:

- Wool or string
- Cardboard (recycled boxes are great for this)
- Marker
- Scissors
- Something circular to trace
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1 Cut the string into seven even pieces.



2 Trace and cut out a cardboard circle using the marker and circular object.



3 Carefully cut eight notches around the edge and a hole in the centre of your cardboard circle.



4 Thread the ends of your strings through the hole in the centre of your cardboard circle and tie them in a knot.



5 Thread the strings into each notch you made. You will have one empty notch.



6 With the empty notch close to you, count three strings around to the right and pick up that string. Move it to the empty notch.



7 Move the new empty notch towards you and repeat step 6 again and again. You will need to detangle the strings and tug the knitting 'tail' from time to time.



8 After a while you will have a beautifully knitted braid to use as a friendship bracelet, key ring or anything else you can think of. To finish it off, remove and knot the strings.
