A great, mess free craft activity to stay entertained while travelling.

You Will Need:

· Wool or string

Scissors

- Cardboard (recycled boxes are great for this)
- Marker
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Something circular to trace



Cut the string into seven even pieces.



Trace and cut out a cardboard circle using the marker and circular object.



Carefully cut eight notches around the edge and a hole in the centre of your cardboard circle.



Thread the ends of your strings through the hole in the centre of your cardboard circle and tie them in a knot.



Thread the strings into each notch you made. You will have one empty notch.



With the empty notch close to you, count three strings around to the right and pick up that string. Move it to the empty notch.



Move the new empty notch towards you and repeat step 6 again and again. You will need to detangle the strings and tug the knitting 'tail' from time to time.



After a while you will have a beautifully knitted braid to use as a friendship bracelet, key ring or anything else you can think of. To finish it off, remove and knot the strings.
